The night hours of 10PM until 7am chief would like to offer a \$100.00 nightly pay compensation along with call-back pay to in district members responding from home or outside members who will stay at station. Night shift is getting harder to cover and with staff willing to stay overnight gives an incentive to work more night shifts.

**APPROVAL TO BEGIN PROCESS TO PURCHASE A NEW AMBULANCE-** Wonder Lake Fire Dept. has purchased 2 ambulances but has decided to only go through with 1 purchase. The Department has offered an opportunity for Hebron FD to purchase the second ambulance at the cost they were given and maintain the wait line of purchase to stay in production. At this time Approx.. Cost is \$360,000 which would come out of budgeted Vehicle line Item. Chief Linneman is looking for approval to purchase ambulance as it is a great opportunity and better deal than we would get but states further details are to come. Upon discussion amongst Board of Trustees V. Scimeca motions to move forward with the purchase with further approvals needed as more

information is to be discussed with Wonder Lake, Seconded by B. Deppmeier. Roll: V. Scimeca-yes, B. Deppmeier-yes, C. Wirfs-yes, E. Elswick-yes
